ANSI Mark Guidelines.

If your BSI issued Certificate of Registration bears the ANSI Accredited Mark, you have been issued with an ANSI-accredited certificate applicable to the standard and scope listed on your certificate.

As a BSI registered organization you may:

• Following approval from ANSI refer to BSI as an ANSI accredited Conformity Assessment Body (CAB) in text only; therefore, are first required to send a request to BSI and following approval display this information using the precise wording approved by ANSI

As a BSI registered organization you shall not:

- Use ANSI Accreditation Mark
- Refer to, use, or reference the ANSI Accreditation Mark in any misleading manner
- Use the ANSI Accreditation Mark in a way as to imply that ANSI has certified or approved any product, person, or service certified by BSI
- Display the ANSI Accreditation Mark on or in connection with any product, its labelling, or packaging

Examples of unacceptable use of the ANSI Marks

Use or registration of ANSI Marks as identifiers in connection with third-party products, services, domain names, social media user names, websites, logos, marketing materials, advertisements, and company letterheads is strictly prohibited. Use or registration of ANSI Marks in self-declarations, such as logos combining ANSI Marks with member (or other) names ("ANSI Member Icon"), is also strictly prohibited. Use of ANSI Marks in a manner that is misleading or incorrectly implies that ANSI endorses, has accredited, or otherwise approves a particular organization, product, or service is strictly prohibited.
