


#### **ISO 14001 Current State**

- Voluntary international standard for environmental management systems
- Many companies in a wide range of industries are certified to the older version; many still needing to get certified to the new version
- There are many certifying bodies, including BSI, who are working to get companies audited and certified by the deadline

# ISO 14001: Understanding Key Changes to the Standard

- Risk Planning
  - Establishes a risk planning process
  - Identifies risk and opportunities
    - » Company's context, interested parties, compliance obligations, environmental apsects
  - Defines actions to address risks and opportunities as part of the EHS processes
    - » Implement, control, evaluate, and review/improve
  - Demonstrate how significant environmental risks and opportunities are being managed throughout supply chain
- Lifecycle Thinking
  - Includes controls for product use and end-of-life
  - Creates direct links between environmentally-driven issues and the business
- Clause 4: Context Setting
  - Describes and demonstrates that the company understands its environmental, social, political, cultural external realities
- Leadership Commitment
  - Must come from the top and be distributed across the organization



## Benefits of EMS, Strengthened by 14001:2015

- Provides for better integration with other business activities, reducing silos
- Requires decentralization and sharing of EMS responsibilities throughout the organization
- Ensures deeper engagement by top management in environmental aspects throughout the company
- Extends a comprehensive whole lifecycle approach across the business
- A certified EMS is now a requirement of GRI and other sustainability reporting frameworks

#### **Contextual Analysis**

- Meets Clause 4 requirement
- Determine interested parties
- Research: External and internal context (climate, land use, bio diversity, political, cultural, social, transparency, governance, etc.)
- Executive stakeholder interviews: C-Suite, supply chain, R&D, etc.

#### **Software Platform**


- Generate report and dashboard

  - Depends upon complexity
  - Customized recommendations
  - Sample tools and examples
  - Findings and Recommendation plus Trackable Actions
  - Timelines and Deliverables
- INTERNAL OR MOCK AUDIT (\$5,000)
  - Following action plan implementation, follow-up audit by different lead auditor
- ONE YEAR SOFTWARE LICENSE (\$5,000)
  - One year of customer use
- TRAININGS (\$5,000+)
  - Internal trainings to EHS and other staff on new requirements at differing training levels (e.g. executive, awareness)
