Invitation to comment on MSPO Initial Assessment of FGVP (M) Sdn Bhd – Waha Palm Oil Mill and supply base, Kota Tinggi, Johor, Malaysia

FGVP (M) Sdn Bhd has appointed BSI to conduct MSPO Initial Assessment of its Waha Palm Oil Mill and supply base. The assessment will be conducted at 1 Palm Oil Mill and 1 Oil Palm Plantation which are managed by the company. The certification unit is located at Kota Tinggi, Johor, Malaysia

BSI plans to conduct initial assessment of Waha Palm Oil Mill from 16 & 17 October 2018.
