#### Overview

# The challenge

#### Solved with standards

As a result of FM Conway following the <u>ISO 39001</u> Road Traffic Safety Management System standard, which helps organizations identify gaps in road safety and minimise operational risks, the company's traffic collision rate went down. This in turn reduced their vehicle maintenance costs.

Their fleet's miles-per-gallon also improved due to careful driving, lowering fuel costs. Their improved safety record and commitment to a road traffic best practice framework also resulted in lower insurance costs. Now that they have the standard in place, FM Conway has a benchmark against which they can continually check their processes and enhance their safe ways of working.

ISO 39001 - The standard sets out the minimum requirements for a Road Traffic Safety Management System. Governments, road authorities, safety groups and private companies were keen to develop such a standard due to the rising number of people killed or injured on the road each year.
