Getting to BSI

Address: Chiswick Tower, 389 Chiswick High Road, London W4 4AL

All visitors must enter the building through the main entrance on Chiswick High Road and report to reception on arrival. BSI reception is on the 1st Floor and open from 8am.

BSI is located above Gunnersbury Station which is served by the District Line, London Overground and several bus routes. In line with BSI's environmental and sustainability principles we encourage visitors to travel using sustainable modes of transport.

Car Parking at BSI

If you are travelling to BSI by car please ensure you reserve a car parking space through BSI reception by emailing

<u>chiswick.reception@bsigroup.com</u> and providing them with the committee reference and date of your meeting, your car make and model along with your registration number.

Visitor parking is accessible, however, if you require a designated disabled parking space which are located near to the building please advise us when booking your parking space.

Accessing the car park

Between 08:00am and 10:30am only – The back entrance to the car park is on Wellesley Road.

Any time – The main entrance to the car park is on Chiswick High Road and can only be accessed going west towards Chiswick Roundabout. Drive past the Wellesley Road back entrance and take the second left into Burlington Road then turn left onto Chiswick High Road. The entrance is on the left just beyond the building.

Bv motor vehicle

From major motorway (M4, M40 and M3) routes. Take the relevant route to Chiswick Roundabout, then take the exit onto A315 (Chiswick High Road), take the second road on the right into Oxford Road North, then turn left onto Wellesley Road.

By Underground

Gunnersbury Station is currently not an accessible station.

- The District line to Richmond stops at Gunnersbury. The Ealing Broadway branch stops at Chiswick Park and you can then walk to BSI via Chiswick High Road.
- The Piccadilly Line can be used to Hammersmith and then change to take the District Line to Richmond.

Nearest Accessible stations to Gunnersbury station

- District and Piccadilly lines—Acton Town
- District line and London Overground—Kew Gardens (Bus route 391 goes to Gunnersbury Station)
- Piccadilly Line—Hammersmith (bus routes H91 and N9 go to Gunnersbury Station)
