Universidade Estadual de Campinas (UNICAMP) is known as a leading university in Brazil. Its main drivers are to maintain its status as a university of quality - one that innovates in the field of education and research; and one that has international aspirations.

The UNICAMP Library System (SBU) is made up of the Central Library "César Lattes" (BC-CL), which coordinates the system, and 19 branch libraries.

UNICAMP attracts more than 200 foreign academics in a wide range of areas and about 180 academics from the best Brazilian universities.

UNICAMP is responsible for around 15% of all Brazilian research and has 53.6% of its students at the graduate level.



According to the Times Higher Education 2012 World University Rankings, UNICAMP is the second best university in both Brazil and Latin America.

The two year BSOL process incorporated their first year of using BSOL in 2011 where

they derived from working on a sixty day trial. This then efficiently followed in 2012 through a new assessment, this time, done by specific researchers for two months.

The BSOL trial was promoted throughout the university. Researchers were then contacted to assess the database.

How BSOL is used:

The University's professors and researchers have been using the database which boasts 53 standards based modules and 3 book modules.
