



## Joint Seminar Tackling Road Risk with ISO 39001

Due to the public-related serious accidents in Hong Kong, the Independent Review Committee on Hong Kong Franchised Bus Service (the Committee) suggested to adopt ISO 39001 Road Transport Management System for the public bus service providers and other related organisations to improve the road safety performance to the drivers, users and general public.

ISO 39001 was created to improve traffic safety by reducing the number of people killed or seriously injured on the roads. Some countries such as Japan and Malaysia have already taken the initiatives to implement the standard a few years ago.

So, what is ISO 39001? How can it be implemented in Hong Kong and what are the benefits? Ir Stephen Yu will lead the participants looking at the issues.
