- Culture and leadership
- Proactive risk management
- Strengthened legal and regulatory compliance

A poor health and safety record can erode the trust of the Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs) you supply and have a negative impact on your reputation. This can lead to:

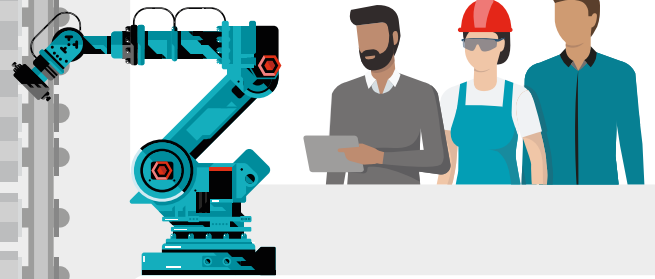
- Poor employee morale and productivity

- Increased morale
- Improved retention and recruitment
- Improvements in quality and productivity



IATF 16949

ISO 45001 is recognized by IATF 16949 as a way organizations may demonstrate meeting the required environment for the operation of processes (Clause 7.1.4). As both standards share the same high level structure, the relationship goes further as there is commonality in the following areas:

- Alignment of strategic direction
- Top management commitment
- The focus on continual improvement
