Rev: Invitation to comment on RSPO Recertification Assessment of Sime Darby Plantation Berhad - New Britain Palm Oil Ltd - Guadalcanal Plains Oil Ltd - Tetere Palm Oil Mill, Supply Base and Scheme Smallholder, North Guadalcanal, Solomon Islands

Sime Darby Plantation Berhad with RSPO Membership No: 1-0008-04-000-00 has appointed BSI to conduct RSPO Recertification Assessment of its Guadalcanal Plains Oil Ltd - Tetere Palm Oil Mill, supply base and scheme smallholder. The assessment will be conducted at one (1) Palm Oil Mill, three (3) estates and four (4) scheme smallholders which are managed by Guadalcanal Plains Oil Ltd. The certification unit is located at North Guadalcanal, Solomon Islands.

BSI plans to conduct recertification assessment of Guadalcanal Plains Oil Ltd - Tetere Palm Oil Mill, supply base and scheme smallholder from 28th - 30th Jan 2021 & 1st Feb 2021 - 5th Feb 2021. The assessment will be conducted based on the Papua New Guinea and Solomon Islands National Interpretation 2019 for RSPO P&C 2018 for the Production of Sustainable Palm Oil. The assessment will cover legal, environment, economical, workers' health and safety, mill supply chain, social aspects, workers welfare, stakeholder engagement and continuous improvement as required by PNG & SI NI.
