**Invitation to comment on RSPO Initial Assessment (Re-assessment) of PT. Meridan Sejatisurya Plantation in Riau Province, Indonesia.**

PT. Meridan Sejatisurya Plantation, an oil palm plantation company under First Resources Ltd., (RSPO Membership No.1-0047-08-000-00), has appointed BSI to conduct an reassessment on the RSPO Initial Assessment for its palm oil mill and supply base. The company located in Kerinci Kanan Village, Kerinci Kanan District, Siak Regency, Riau Province – Indonesia.

BSI plans to conduct re-assessment of PT. Meridan Sejatisurya Plantation on 30<sup>th</sup> May – 1<sup>st</sup> June 2018. As for information, the Initial Assessment/Stage 2 Assessment have been carried out on 29<sup>th</sup> June – 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2015. This re-assessment will be conducted against RSPO Principles and Criteria; RSPO Certification System June 2007 (Revised March 2011), included Annex 4; Indonesia National Interpretation September 2016; RSPO Supply Chain Certification Standard, June 2017; and RSPO Supply Chain Certification System, June 2017. The assessment will cover legal, environment, economical, workers' health and safety, and social aspects as required by RSPO P&C.
